## INDIANA LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY QUALFICATION HANDGUN COURSE

When designing a course of fire, which accommodates all, makes, models, and ammunition capacities some concessions are made which allow each to be used in training and qualification. Weapon ammunition capacities range from 6 rounds to 18 rounds with many having a number between the two. The following course of fire meets the requirement of the Indiana Law Enforcement Training Board.

## 48 Round Qualification Pistol Course

1st Stage - 3 -yard line -12 rounds -6 rounds fired one handed with the strong hand and 6 rounds fired one handed with the support the hand. On command load and holster. Shooters may load with 6 or 12 rounds. On command fire 2 shot strings. Six (6) with strong hand only and 6 with the support hand only. Once the weapon clears the holster all firing is completed before weapon is re-holstered. A 10 second delay between strong hand firing and support hand firing will allow shooters a reloading period if necessary. Each 2 rounds will have a 3 second face time. When the stage of fire is completed the command to ceasefire, clear and holster all weapons will be given. When the line is safe the command to move to the 7 -yard line will be given.

2nd Stage - 7 -yard line - 12 rounds - all 12 rounds fired 2 handed below eye level - 20 second time limit. On command load and holster. Shooters may load with 6 or 12 rounds. On command fire, when firing is completed unload and holster an empty weapon. When the line is safe, the command to move to the 15-yard line will be given.

3rd Stage - 15-yard line - 12 rounds - 6 rounds fired standing point shoulder and 6 rounds fired kneeling - 25 second time limit. On command load and holster. Shooters may load with 6 or 12 rounds. On command fire 6 rounds standing point shoulder and complete by firing 6 rounds in the kneeling position. Kneeling may be 1 or 2 knees down with the elbow supported or unsupported. Cease-fire, unload, stand and holster. When line is safe, the command to move to the 25-yard line will be given.

4th Stage - 25 -yard line - 12 rounds - standing barricade, left and right handed - 50 -second time limit. On command, load and holster. Shooters may load with 6 or 12 rounds. On command, fire 6 rounds left hand from the left side of the barricade and 6 rounds right hand from the right side of the barricade. Shooter may use the barricade for light support. Ceasefire, unload and holster.

Possible Score -- 240
Requirement --- Officer must fire an $80 \%$ or a minimum score of 192 to qualify. Officer must fire the course (3) times and all (3) attempts
must be a score of 192 or above.

## ILEA - 48 Round Scoring System

 (B27 Standard Target)1. All Bullet Holes inside the 8 Ring or cutting the 8 Ring count as 5 points.
2. All Bullet Holes inside the 7 Ring or cutting the 7 Ring count as 4 points.
3. All Bullet Holes Outside of the 7 Ring cutting the blue silhouette target count as 3 points.
4. All Bullet Holes that are not touching the silhouette or cannot be accounted for count as 0 points.
